

PRE-SOLICITATION NOTICE

Date of Posting: May 14, 2024

The United States Probation and Pretrial Services Office for the District of Connecticut intends to procure treatment services for federal defendants and persons under supervision using Blanket Purchase Agreements. Agreements are for the period beginning October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025, with a provision for the Government to unilaterally extend the agreement in accordance with Section I, Clause 2-90D, Option to Extend the Term, for an additional four years, at (4) twelve-month intervals. Required services include, but are not limited to, urine collection/testing; case management services; assessments/evaluations; counseling in the areas of substance use, mental health, co-occurring disorders, sexual behaviors; sex offense specific polygraph examinations; short-term inpatient residential treatment; and medication monitoring.

On or after June 14, 2024. Request for Proposals (RFP) will be posted on the agency's web page at <https://www.ctp.uscourts.gov>. Please note the email address for submissions includes an *underscore* between CTP and Contracting team.

Interested offerors must respond on time to solicitation deadlines and clearly show: (1) they can provide services within the catchment area with a facility available for use, (2) such services will be provided by professionals meeting the experience and criteria required, and (3) prices of such treatment shall be as low or lower than those charged to the offeror's most favored customer for comparable quantities under similar terms and conditions.

Proposals are due by **Tuesday, July 9, 2024, at 5:00 pm EST**. All Request for Proposals can be submitted in Hard Copy, one (1) Original and one (1) copy to the U.S. Probation & Pretrial Services Office at 157 Church Street, 17th Fl., New Haven, CT 06510, Attention: Marlyn R. Pollard, Procurement Administrator. It is the responsibility of the offeror to confirm the government's receipt of the proposal.
